### **COVID-19 Frequently Asked Questions:**

**Q1. What safety precautions are you taking to prevent COVID-19?**

Temperatures: staff and student temperatures are taken upon arrival, departure and at mealtime during the day while on facility premises.

Hand Washing: staff and students are required to wash their hands using CDC recommended handwashing procedures throughout the day using warm running water and rubbing with soap for at least 20 seconds.

Shoes: staff and students must bring a pair of shoes to the facility that will ONLY be worn inside this facility and will be left here each evening. The "facility only shoes" will be sanitized by staff each night.

Social Distancing: we have reduced our group sizes to 1 teacher for 9 students for 10-hour days per class. Students and staff are not intermingled during the day.

Intensified Cleaning: Routine cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting occurs daily. Soft toys, rugs and items that are not easy to clean have been removed from the classrooms.

**Q2. Are parents allowed inside the building?**

During COVID-19, parents will NOT be permitted to enter the facility. In the event of an emergency requiring parents to enter the building, he/she MUST wash hands, remove shoes, wear a mask and practice social-distancing with everyone except for your child.

**Q3. Are children required to wear masks?**

It is recommended that children 3 years of age and up wear a mask, but it is not required.

**Q4. What is the sick policy?**

If during the day, a child exhibits any of the following symptoms the child will be separated from the rest of the people in the center and MUST be picked up within 30 minutes. They must be symptom and medication free for 72 hours before returning to school.

- fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
- dry cough
- Shortness of Breath
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Loss of taste or smell
- Sore Throat
- Muscle aches
- headaches

*Note: We understand that many of these symptoms may not be related to COVID-19 however we must proceed with an abundance of caution during this Public Health Emergency.*

**Q5. What happens if someone at the school has COVID-19?**

If there is a confirmed case of COVID-19, we will immediately notify Child Care Licensing. Together with the guidance of the Health Department, we will devise a plan of action. Parents will be notified and additional cleaning will take place.
