PLANNING POINTS FOR REOPENING

Learning Options were due. Contact your campus directly if yours wasn't made.

Learning Options are set for at least 9 weeks

In the event of a directive from the health department or a State Executive Order, a classroom/school closure may be required

Masks will be required for all on-site based learning

Schools will be open 5 days per week with normal operating hours

Temperature Checks for all prior to campus entry

Three Learning Options for Student Learning

1

DISTANCE LEARNING

Students attend school 5 days per week via KCC Virtual Learning

2

HYBRID LEARNING

Students attend school virtually and on-site 5 days per week

3

ON-SITE LEARNING

Students attend school onsite 5 days per week

During this time, just as when we are not dealing with a pandemic, the safety of students and staff and high-quality learning are our top priorities.

Guiding Principles for Reopening

Kid's Community College® has identified five principles to guide all planning for school reopening.

1. Ensure safe learning and working environments for students and staff.
2. Maximize family choice in student learning formats, offering three options for families.
3. Ensure all students receive instruction that meets state and federal standards and have the necessary supports for success, including:
 - Access to technology and connectivity;
 - Social-emotional wellness and health supports; and
 - Additional supports to meet needs of special populations.
4. Provide training, time, support, and flexibility necessary for staff to prepare for successful reopening.
5. Provide proactive, clear communication (with translations as needed) to all families and staff

- All KCC Charter School campuses will reopen on August 24th unless an Executive Order or health agency directive is issued to keep schools closed.
- Students will have three options to attend class: distance learning, hybrid learning or onsite learning.
- Schools will be open five days per week, in accordance with the following schedule:

- Riverview Southeast (McMullen) Elementary 8:30a - 2:55p, Middle 8:15a - 3:25p
- Preparatory High School (Johanna) 7:30a - 3:00p
- Distance and Hybrid Learning operating hours will be the same as above. All students must check in daily between 8:30a - 8:40a for Elementary, 8:15a - 8:25a for middle and 7:30a - 7:40a for high school. Homeroom teacher will provide online attendance link.
- Buildings and classrooms will be sanitized **at least** once during the school day and nightly.
- Masks will be required for anyone on-site.
- Temperature checks will be performed on everyone prior to entry each day. Anyone with a temperature of 99.5° F or higher will not be permitted on campus.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be located at every entry and throughout the building.
- All KCC Associates will be required to complete the KCC COVID Return to Work course.
- The following social distancing and health precautions will be implemented:
 - Staggered Bell Times to prevent congregating large numbers of students
 - Staggered Lunch Schedules or alternating lunches in classrooms
 - Staggered Middle And High School hallway passing times
 - Marking hallways for traffic flow
 - Ensuring students interact with the same limited number of students regularly to the fullest extent possible
 - Eliminating unnecessary on-site visitors
 - Spacing classroom seating further apart or providing partitions when necessary
 - Increased custodial support with more frequent sanitizing schedules
